Principal's Reports:

Enfield: raised \$9000 for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. Spring picture day will be on April 1st. Kindergarten registration, parent night will be April 3rd at 6:30-7:30 for incoming parents. Special thanks to the parents for supporting the event. 2nd grade will be participating for Pioneer Day on Friday, 3/29. 4th and 5th graders will be participating in the Reading Olympics competition in Cheltenham. Swim Gym will begin April 21st, take a break for PSSA testing, and restart. Will occur during PE time and will be walked up by classroom teachers. Swim materials will need to be brought on. Butterfly Garden will be run by the garden committee. High school student would like to start an outside classroom in order to earn his Eagle's scout award. Student will rip out the butterfly garden and replace it with grass for the students to use as an area for reading and working outside. Goal to enhance this space will be \$1300, mostly try to fundraise this amount, but would be great for the EEHSP to contribute a portion of the costs. Wax Museum for 5th graders was discussed. Same concepts as before, what would be different will be who they represent. A career interest survey will be created to gain interest on career areas that students can research and find a famous person that had that career and/or represent that career.
